- Your **Interactive Study Homework (IS)** should be completed on the day for which it is assigned. You must link your IS account to your instructor's by means of a class group code. You will receive this code from the instructor in class, on Sakai, and by e-mail in the first week of classes. The code enables the instructor to see that you have completed the assignments and give you credit. See Course Policies for more on this procedure and the grading of these assignments.

(Reminder: Do NOT use Google Translate or other translation programs.)
- A small asterisk * indicates homework that needs to be submitted as a hard copy in class.
- There are additional grammar explanations with exercises on the *Weiter geht's* Interactive online. You are only required to complete the exercises assigned on the syllabus. The other exercises are designed to give you the opportunity for additional practice, and we may do some of these exercises in class.
- It is your responsibility to study the vocabulary in each unit. To demonstrate your knowledge of these words, there will be **Vocab Quizzes** at the beginning of the class sessions listed on the syllabus. Please ask your instructor if you have any questions.
- If you have any questions about an assignment, please ask your instructor before the due date. Late or incorrectly completed assignments will negatively affect your grade.
